PM- Interventional
Rehabilitative
Paliative
Long-term medication management of chronic physical pain

Problem- old, 2002 Sun Sentinel / deaths and computer system
FDLE 03 - 08 drugs prescribed in pain management
no one - even those with the power to do so - has stopped this atrocity

Prevalance- NT / CL pain meds as easy to find as a MCD drive through
no other med field that advertises this way

Reason- addicts (gas / fire)
Drug Co (make - improperly market - NOT RX)
doctors (bad doctors - prostitution - always be around - infestation - ads NT/CL) - WHY?
protect public - dr's dealing - drugs killing
not doing enough
protect the health and safety of all Floridians
Medical boards

Boards- DO vs MD
PM rules FAC 64B15-14.005 (DO)
FAC 64B8-9.013 (MD)
useless - not much more tx common cold
protect the health and safety of all Floridians - why FDLE 15195
because boards stand by - dr's hide behind
DEA can't touch - kill - not illegal - board require
2005 rule proposal - ignored
Emergency Rule - individual emergency orders
Statewide Emergency RULE 3ER's/2000
5->3 2000 - - - >15K->0
can't stop legitimate tx? - board's smart enough
2000 - exempted dentistry
No new outpts <60 days - - or letter brd stating why
No disp - I never sold controlled sub - independ pharm
No advert - my OBOT ad
No out state pts

make the boards accountable for their inaction

not protecting health and safety of all Floridians
not doing at least as much - did under far less serious conditions
2000 - 3 Statewide Emergency Rules - 5 deaths
end 09 - 19,000

1. Track Sys- not have to start until the end of 2010 (thousands more will die)
only track cash pay patients (insurance not tracked)
15 days to input data from Rx date
not have to look at any data
no FL tax money (grant or Federal tax \$)
2. Meeting Aug 29, 2009 why taken 15,195
how will they specifically drug deaths (data 6 yr)
no specific answer - look to their past behavior
3. Where's the STATE WIDE EMERGENCY RULE
not individual emergency order
sticking finger in dike
as effective as handing out umbrellas during Katrina
4. If what they've done is working - - why 15,195 dead bodies

MAKE THE MEDICAL BOARDS ACCOUNTABLE

deaths 3 types expected (terminal illness - cancer - palliative PM)
unexpected - not due to pain medications (other medical conditions)
unexpected - due to pain medications -> FDLE

2005 state attorney about 200 PM pill-mill doctors / FL
2301 deaths
2301 / 200 -> 11 deaths/dr 2005
avg dr 7 yrs = 77 deaths

7 yrs average less 1 death / yr
